Sing with Strings 2022 **PERFECT PITCH**

hosted by the Bernardi Music Group in association with the Yehudi Menuhin School and the String Academy, and supported by Arts Council England

The Bernardi Music Group's **String Academy** is inviting 20 gifted and talented young string players from the county to play alongside the string orchestra from the world-renowned **Yehudi Menuhin School** in this year's **Sing with Strings** project. We would like to invite your child to be one of those string players.

Sing with Strings 2022 will bring together a **massed children's choir** of **over 200 singers** from more than 7 of the county's primary and secondary schools to sing alongside an **orchestra** of strings, piano and percussion.

In this World Cup year, we will be performing **Perfect Pitch**, a selection of fun football-themed songs by composer **Malcolm Singer** setting the rhythmically inventive and entertaining poems of **Nick Toczek**.

The orchestra will rehearse with composer/conductor **Malcolm Singer** and join the massed choir led by choirmaster **Mark Bradbury** (Little Notes, Build an Opera) for two rehearsals, and there will also be an orchestral rehearsal (for the orchestras of both Surrey and Sussex, where we are running the project in tandem). The project will culminate in a dress rehearsal and two performances at **Charterhouse School**.

This is a very special opportunity to collaborate with pupils from other local schools, professional musicians and play with a spectacular orchestra!

TRANSPORT & AUTHORISED ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

Arrangements for transport to and from all rehearsals and the performance day will be the responsibility of the child's parents/guardians. Please gain the appropriate authority for your child's absence from school for these rehearsals and the performance day afternoon, as appropriate.

TICKETS & BOOKING

Special booking codes will be provided on 12 September, enabling parents and families of participants to purchase tickets at a significant discount: Adults @ £10, children aged 5+ @ £5 (full price tickets @ £15 for all).

SAFEGUARDING

There will be two String Academy tutors to chaperone and supervise children participating in the string orchestra at rehearsals and on the performance day. The Bernardi Music Group will ensure that all project leaders and String Academy tutors have an up-to-date enhanced DBS check.

Please ensure your child registers in and out with the designated String Academy tutor upon arrival and before collection.

AUDIOVISUAL CONSENT

As part of the legacy of *Sing with Strings*, the Bernardi Music Group will be making audiovisual recordings of the rehearsals and performances during this project.

We would like to ask your permission to record, store and edit audio, video and photographic images of this project which may include the child in your care. These may be shared and used by the Bernardi Music Group in formats including, but not limited to, printed displays, online and printed publications, and use on websites and social media.

PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT FORM FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

This is a fantastic and inspirational opportunity for young and gifted string players to join the String Academy to play alongside players from the Yehudi Menuhin School and to work with professional musicians. It is fully funded by Arts Council England and offered at no cost to participants. In return for this opportunity, we ask of the participants and their parents/guardians to give the following commitment:

- To attend all rehearsals and the performance day as detailed above, bringing their instrument and a music stand.
- To practise and learn the music independently and with their instrumental teachers outside of the orchestral rehearsals. Your child will receive the music at the first rehearsal and it will be appropriate to their playing ability.
- For parents/guardians to arrange transport to and from all rehearsals and the performance day.
(If your child is at one of the schools participating in the massed choir, it may be possible for you to arrange transport from school to the rehearsals that involve the choir; please arrange this directly with your child's school, if appropriate.)
- For parents/guardians to gain the appropriate authorisation from their child's school to allow them to be absent in order to attend the rehearsals and performance day afternoon.
